
## **Executive Summary**

# Faith Community Consultation: A Strategy Session for Systemic Change

Creating tools for faith, health, and community leaders to "Fight On"

On February 21, 2025, faith and community leaders, educators, policymakers, and advocates gathered in Indianapolis for the 4th **Faith Community Consultation**—a pivotal moment in Indiana's ongoing efforts to improve health, education, and general welfare. Hosted by the Indiana Ministerium in collaboration with The AfricaLogical Institute and the Interdisciplinary Research Leaders (IRL) program of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, the consultation created space for urgent conversations, strategic action, and sustained collaboration.

Centered around three core panel discussions—health, education, and welfare—the Faith Community Consultation created a platform for shared learning and cross-sector strategy. Panel Moderators included Dr. Ivan Douglas Hicks, Dr. David Craig, and Dr. Gwen Kelley, who facilitated rich discussions on current legislative threats, policy gaps, and organizing opportunities to uplift Indiana's most vulnerable residents. ## **Community Engagement & Infrastructure**

A core success factor of the Faith Community Consultation was its comprehensive engagement and execution strategy, which ensured the event's reach, resonance, and replicability. Supporting partners, including <a href="Onyx Rising">Onyx Rising</a>, a change management consulting firm, were instrumental in developing and executing the full event infrastructure, which included:

- Marketing and Communications Strategy
- Social Media Posting Plan
- Invitation Video and Post-Event Thank You Video
- Press Release and Media Coordination
- Branded Program Agenda
- Panelist Run-of-Show and Facilitation Materials
- Promotional Flyers
- Pre-Event Briefings and Stakeholder Alignment Meetings

This holistic approach led to strong in-person attendance and virtual participation, signaling both community readiness and institutional alignment around the FCC's objectives.

## **Communications & Legacy Tools**

The Faith Community Consultation was professionally filmed and later developed into a full-length documentary titled *Fight On*, capturing the tone, urgency, and leadership of the day. Transcripts of the meeting were also produced for further analysis, accessibility, and archiving.

As a result of this work, *Fight On* has expanded into a growing body of tools and resources that communities across the country can use to educate, organize, and advocate. These include:

Additional communications and engagement tools that support replication in other cities and states including this "Fight On" - Medicaid Panoply document are full of tools to continue the fight for change.

## **Outcomes & Impact**

The Faith Community Consultation catalyzed a series of next steps across Indiana's advocacy landscape, reinvigorating cross-sector networks and inspiring additional coalition-building. The model presented through the Faith Community Consultation—built on a foundation of **faith leadership**, **civic engagement**, **and policy awareness**—is now being shared with communities across the U.S. as a scalable approach to coordinated change.

Faith institutions have emerged from this process not only as moral leaders but as **strategic partners** in the fight for access, equity, and justice. What began in 2021 with a small group of community and faith leaders, now serves as a **replicable framework** and toolset for others committed to building stronger, healthier, and more informed communities.
